

#03 INFECTION

 Bad smell and coloring in secretions with the patient at home.

CONSULT



- 5 to 7 days after procedure

 Normal: when coughing or at
- Bleeding through cannula or stoma

performing respiratory therapy.

After 7 days of procedure head over to the ER.



#01 BRONCOASPIRATION

Food step towards the lungs.

#02 CHOKE / ASPHYXIA

The patient is full of secretions.

- SWEATING
 - NASAL FLARING
 - Perform suction therapy.



#05
DECANNULATION

Tracheostomy cannula output.

- VOMIT
- FOOD WASTES IN MOUTH

Stop nutrition and perform respiratory therapy through trachea.

Make sure to locate your patient in the right position.

CONSULT

 Occlude the hole with gauze and provide oxygen to the patient by a mask in mouth and nose.

If it's a chronic patient, provide oxygen directly to the tracheostomy.

HEAD OVER TO THE ER!
