**INSTRUCTIONS FOR SAMPLE COLLECTION OR PATIENT'S PREPARATION
DETECTION OF CHLAMYDIA TRACHOMATIS/NEISSERIA GONORRHOEAE IN
URINE**

Dear patient,

In order to ensure a reliable result, please follow the recommendations below:

- **Do not** collect the sample in the period within 3 days before until 3 days after the end of the menstrual period
- **Do not** use a vaginal douching, vaginal powder (Vagisil®) or vaginal creams from the day before the sample collection
- **Do not** wash your genitals the day of sample collection
- In a new urine container, collect **the first part of the urine stream of the first morning urine, and close the container tightly.**
- Immediately transport the container with the sample to the laboratory (before 5 hours have elapsed).

Remember that according to Law 100/1993, it is the patients' DUTY, to take self-care measures and adhere to their Treating Physician recommendations.
