2. HOLDER'S RIGHTS: As the holder of your personal data, you have the following rights: (i) Free access to personal data provided that have been processed. (ii) To know, update, and rectify your information against partial, inaccurate, incomplete, fractioned, or misleading data or any data whose processing is prohibited or unauthorized. (iii) To request proof of granted authorization. (iv) To submit complaints to the competent authority regarding breaches of the provisions set forth in the current regulations. (v) To withdraw the authorization and/or request the deletion of data, as long as there is no legal or contractual duty that prevents its deletion. (vi) To refrain from answering questions about sensitive data. Answers concerning sensitive data or data on children and adolescents shall be optional.
